



## **5th European Radiation Protection Week (ERPW)**

22-24 November 2021, Vienna/AT

### **General Terms and Conditions for Registration and Participation**

These General Terms and Conditions stipulate the regulations for the registration for and participation in the 5<sup>th</sup> European Radiation Protection Week in Vienna (hereinafter referred to as “ERPW”), hosted by the European Alliance for Medical Radiation Protection Research (EURAMED), a non-profit organisation according to Austrian Law with its registered office in 1010 Vienna, Am Gestade 1 (hereinafter referred to as “EURAMED”).

#### **General**

---

##### **1 Registration**

- 1.1 Registration for ERPW is to be made electronically by using the respective registration form provided on the EURAMED homepage ([www.euramed.eu](http://www.euramed.eu)). Incomplete registration forms cannot be processed.
- 1.2 A contractual relationship subject to these Terms and Conditions is entered into between EURAMED and the participant. If the payment of the participant’s registration fee is to be invoiced to and borne by a third party such as a university, an operator of a hospital or other health care institution or a business corporation, the contractual relationship subject to these Terms and Conditions is entered into between EURAMED and such third party.
- 1.3 Upon registration, the participant shall receive an e-mail confirming registration for verification of the participant's personal data and including the invoice for the registration fee, which is provided on the EURAMED homepage ([www.euramed.eu](http://www.euramed.eu)).
- 1.4 Payment of the registration fee can be made only via bank transfer to the bank account indicated on the invoice. Any bank charges incurred are to be paid by the participant. Payment via bank transfer has to be made within 10 working days from receipt of the invoice so that the registration is finalised.
- 1.5 The participant's registration for ERPW 2021 shall not become effective until EURAMED has received the full due registration fee.
- 1.6 Registration to ERPW 2021 is non-transferable. New registration and payment are required.
- 1.7 Conference registration for onsite participation is open until 31 October 2021. No late registration at the conference venue will be possible. If participant wants to change the onsite

registration to an online registration, EURAMED has to be informed in writing by email to [erpw2021@eibir.org](mailto:erpw2021@eibir.org) until 31 October 2021.

- 1.8 Conference registration for online participation is open until 31 October 2021. If participant wants to change the registration for online participation to onsite participation, EURAMED has to be informed in writing by email to [erpw2021@eibir.org](mailto:erpw2021@eibir.org) until 31 October 2021.

## **2 Force Majeure**

- 2.1 If, for any reason, holding ERPW 2021 becomes impossible due to reasons of force majeure, including but not limited to blackout, strikes, natural disasters, epidemics, pandemics, government regulations, internet failure or hacker attack, there will be no refund of participation fees already paid. EURAMED's obligation to perform ERPW 2021 remains unaffected and EURAMED is entitled to hold the ERPW 2021 as full online conference (instead of a hybrid conference with onsite and online participation) or postpone ERPW 2021 until such time the event of force majeure no longer exists.

## **3 Access to ERPW online service and terms of use for online participation**

- 3.1 Access to the content of ERPW 2021 is granted from 22-24 November 2021 for online and onsite participants.
- 3.2 To access ERPW 2021, a non-exclusive, non-transferable and limited license to the participant named in the contract is granted only for personal use and for the duration of the ERPW 2021.
- 3.3 The materials made available during ERPW 2021 may only be displayed on one single user screen (personal computer, tablet) per participant at a time.
- 3.4 The participant's account granting access to ERPW 2021 may not be transferred to a third person and access data may not be disclosed.
- 3.5 The content presented at ERPW 2021 contains material contributed or licensed by individuals, or organisations that may be protected by Austrian and foreign copyright laws. Participant shall not reproduce, archive, modify, distribute, publicly perform, publish or license any of the content and information available for ERPW or obtained from or through ERPW. Participant shall not create derivative works or offer them for sale.
- 3.6 Participant shall not bypass, remove, change, downgrade, disable or prevent any copy protection in the ERPW 2021 online service. Participant shall not use robots, spiders, web scraping, or other automated operations to access ERPW. Participant shall not decompile, reverse engineer, or disassemble any software or any other product or process accessible through the ERPW 2021 online service. Participant shall not insert any code or other product or otherwise tamper with the ERPW 2021 online service. Participant shall not use data mining, data collection or other extraction methods. Participant shall not upload, post, email, or otherwise send or transmit any content that interferes with, suspends or restricts the operation of any computer software/hardware or telecommunications equipment in connection with the ERPW 2021 online service. This also applies to any software viruses or other codes, files and programs.
- 3.7 In the event of violation of these terms of use, or in the event of use in an illegal or fraudulent manner, EURAMED may terminate or restrict participant's use of and access to the ERPW 2021 online service.

## **4 Place of Performance/Applicable Law/Place of Jurisdiction**

- 4.1 The place of performance of any duties and obligations for both EURAMED and the participant sides shall be Vienna.
- 4.2 Any contractual relationship with EURAMED shall be subject to Austrian law, with the exception of the Vienna Convention on the International Sale of Goods.
- 4.3 The place of jurisdiction shall be 1010 Vienna. EURAMED shall also be entitled to pursue any claim before the courts of law competent for the defendant's domicile or general residence.

### **5 Cancellation**

- 5.1 Participants have the right to cancel the contract without giving any reasons.
- 5.2 In order to exercise the right of cancellation, the participant must inform EURAMED, by means of a clear written statement to [erpw2021@eibir.org](mailto:erpw2021@eibir.org) of the decision to withdraw from the contract, incl. bank account details to which the repayment should be done.
- 5.3 If the participant cancels this contract, EURAMED will refund to such participant payments EURAMED has received from participant without delay and at the latest within 14 days from the date on which EURAMED received notice of the cancellation of this contract, as follows:  
  
If the cancellation email is received between 1 July 2021 and 31 August 2021 at the latest, one hundred per cent (100%) will be reimbursed.  
  
If the cancellation email is received between 1 September 2021 and 31 October 2021 at the latest, fifty per cent (50%) will be reimbursed.  
  
If the cancellation email is received after 31 October 2021, no reimbursement will be provided.
- 5.4 After withdrawal, the respective service cannot be accessed.

### **6 Withdrawal**

- 6.1 Participants have the right to withdraw from the contract within 14 days without giving any reasons. This 14-day withdrawal period begins on the day the contract is concluded.
- 6.2 In order to exercise the right of withdrawal, the participant must inform EURAMED, by means of a clear written statement to [erpw2021@eibir.org](mailto:erpw2021@eibir.org) of the decision to withdraw from the contract, incl. bank account details to which the repayment should be done. The withdrawal period is respected if the participant sends his declaration of withdrawal within the withdrawal period. For this purpose, the following sample form may (but does not have to) be downloaded from <https://www.euramed.eu/erpw/registration>.
- 6.3 If the participant withdraws from this contract, EURAMED will refund to such participant any payments EURAMED has received from him without delay and at the latest within 14 days from the date on which EURAMED received notice of the withdrawal of this contract.
- 6.4 After withdrawal, the respective service cannot be accessed.
